 - College policies
 - Explore career paths Academic/Workforce
 - Final Degree Plan
 - Pre-advising
 - Educate students of student success support services
 - Assign Academic or Workforce Advisor
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THE ROLE OF THE ACADEMIC/WORKFORCE ADVISOR

- Assist in finalizing admission requirements
 - Clarify educational goal
 - Establish a projected graduation date
 - Evaluate TSI requirements
 - Review for transfer credit
 - Develop a meaningful Cooperative Educational Plan
 - Collaborate, identify, and develop a plan to address barriers to success
 - Case-management style advising
 - Utilize Student Success Support Services
 - Refer to financial aid and admission for policy and procedure (Add/drop courses)
 - Encourage student course evaluation and course selection
