SENIOR YEAR CHECKLIST

AUGUST-SEPTEMBER:

- Attend senior meetings to make sure you are meeting college admission requirements
- Search college websites for information
- Register and take the ACT and/or SAT
- Attend college fairs
- Attend college/university preview days
- · Begin apply to colleges/universities with early admissions
- Apply for any scholarships available
- Create or Revise your Resume

OCTOBER-NOVEMBER:

- Narrow your list of colleges down to three to five schools
- · Observe deadlines for admission and scholarship applications
- Submit college and scholarship applications
- Ask teachers, counselor, and others for recommendations (only if required)
- Request an official transcript to be sent to each prospective college/university
- · Apply for any scholarships available
- · Update your resume

DECEMBER-JANUARY:

- Complete your housing application(s) and send in your housing deposit
- Write application essays and ask parents, teachers, and/or counselors to read first drafts

- Continue your scholarship search
- Keep your resume up to date

JANUARY-MARCH:

- Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) as soon after October 1 as possible
- Attend financial aid seminars
- Send mid-term report and first semester grades to prospective schools
- Decide on the college you plan to attend
 - -notify the school of decision by May 1 or specific college deadline
- · Observe deadlines for sending in your final paperwork, fees, and deposits
- Continue to look for scholarships
- Take the TSI either at your local school or the college/university of your choice
- Check your e-mail for your SAR (Student Aid Report)
